Currently a "Top 10" national Second-crop sire in 2013, **Heatseeker** now has single-crop earnings approaching \$600,000, 17 first-crop winners, three stakes performers including a \$150,000 stakes winner, and two-turn maiden special winners at Santa Anita, Tampa Bay and Laurel.

One of only two active California sires represented by a stakes winner at Santa Anita in 2013, **Tizbud** is also the sire of the G3-placed 3-year-old Nina's Dragon, who rallied four wide for second in the \$200,000 El Camino **Real Derby** at 1 1/8 miles in his stakes debut.

Unbridled's Song-Festal, by Storm Bird The only multiple Grade 1-winning millionaire by his sire standing outside of Kentucky was bred to 54 mares in 2012 - 47 pronounced in foal.

Pulpit-Lucky Soph, by Cozzene Second highest Lifetime A-E Index (1.71) among active California sires, and with one exception - **Tapit** - the highest among sons of **Pulpit** at stud.

Cee's Tizzy-Lucky C. H., by A. P. Indy

Graded winner of \$632,065 has three first-crop winners and one-placed from four starters. His first "full season at stud" crop will race this year.
