In a two-year period, **Cee's Tizzy** sired 1999 Breeders' Cup Classic second-place finisher **Budroyale** and 2000-2001 Breeders' Cup Classic winner and 2000 Horse-of-the-Year **Tiznow**.

With 2001 Eclipse Award champions **Tiznow** and **Gourmet Girl**, **Cee's Tizzy** became only the fifth sire since 1988 to have two divisional champions in a single season, and still remains the only sire of two California-bred national champions.

The first California stallion to have back-to-back annual progeny earnings surpass \$5,000,000, Cee's Tizzy is the leading sire of California-bred millionaires: all-time leader Tiznow (G1, \$6,427,830), Budroyale (G2, \$2,840,810), Gourmet Girl (G1, \$1,255,373) and Cost of Freedom (G1, \$1,018,799).
