Smiling Tiger began his brilliant career with a :46 1/5 wire-to-wire, 6-length victory in his 2-year-old debut, and in the 22 starts to follow, he finished among the top three in 16 of 20 graded stakes, including a length decision as the favorite in his final start when he defeated five-time Grade I winner Private Zone.

An Eclipse Award finalist at 3, **Smiling Tiger** recorded Beyers of 95 or higher 16 times and nine Triple Digit figures at five different race tracks, including **Grade I** victories in the Triple Bend (112), Bing Crosby (103) and Ancient Title (104) Stakes.

First crop of 71 foals will be yearlings of 2016; 77 mares bred in 2015.


