Nureyev – Rossard, by Glacial

The only California sire to lead the sire list six times and have progeny earnings surpass \$4 Million for seven consecutive years.

Last year's 2-year-olds averaged \$7,015 per start and \$25,429 per runner for eight starters, four winners and two record setters.

Cee's Tizzy – Lucky C. H. by A.P. Indy

Progeny earnings now top \$1 million and a solid average earnings per runner of \$27,930 for 39 starters is 19-times his stud fee.

Hold That Tiger – Shandra Smiles, by Cahill Road

Triple **G1** winner of \$1.48 Million recorded 16 Beyers at 95 or higher and 9 Triple Digit Figures up to 112. 1st foals arriving now.

TIZBUD

Cee's Tizzy – Cee's Song, by Seattle Song

G1 sire of champion **Tiz Flirtatious** (\$779,800), record-setting miler **Soi Phet** (\$474,976) and **G3**-placed **Ambitious Brew** (\$247,920).

Fee: \$1,500 Live Foal
